

LICENSE AGREEMENT

This License is granted to You in connection with Your Order of the CD-ROM entitled **HEAD AND NECK ANATOMY FOR HEALTH PROFESSIONALS** (collectively, the "Course Materials").

1. **License.** You are hereby granted a limited, personal, non-exclusive right on the terms set forth in this License to install and use the Course Materials on a single computer by each student and instructor described in the Order.
