Report, #ME 04-386, 29 Jun 04, which listed the cause of death as atherosclerotic cardiovascular
disease and manner of death as natural causes, which is consistent with previously reported

DETAILS

BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION: On 22 May 04, this office was notified by 391st Military Police (MP) Battalion (BN), Baghdad Correctional Confinement Facility (BCCF), Abu Ghryeb, Iraq (AGI), that Detainee Abduhl Kaddim ALTIA, National Detainee Reporting System (NDRS) #159496, died as a result of cardiac arrest.

About 1130, 22 May 04, SA *7C-1 66-1* interviewed MAJ (DR) *7C-3 66-3* 848th Forward Surgical Team (FST), BCCF, AGI, who stated ALTIA was brought to the emergency room at 1055 with no signs of life after collapsing at Ganci #5. He said CPR was being performed and an IV was in place. He said emergency life saving procedures were continued for approximately 10 minutes, but ALTIA regained signs of life. DR *7C3 663* pronounced ALTIA deceased at 1107, 22 May 04, as a result of cardiac arrest. DR *7C3 663* stated he did not see any signs of trauma that would suggest anything other than cardiac arrest. He provided the emergency care medical files of ALTIA. (Death Certificate and Medical Records)

About 1150, 22 May 04, SA *7C1 661* exposed photographs of ALTIA using a Kodak Digital Camera. (See Compact Disc)

AGENT'S COMMENT: Upon inspection of the body, this agent did not observe any signs of trauma or abuse.

About 1210, 22 May 04, SA *7C1-661* with the assistance of Interpreter *7C3 66-3* 391st MP BN, BCCF, AGI interviewed Detainee *75F-366-3* DRS # *7C 66* son of ALTIA. He stated that he was unaware of any past heart condition his father may have suffered, but did state his father was diabetic. He stated ALTIA fell down two days prior and complained of chest pain. ALTIA did not report it to the Army medics, but rather took his diabetes medicine. He further stated that his ALTIA was fine on the morning of 22 May 04, but, at about 1030, ALTIA complained of chest pain and shortness of breath. He stated ALTIA fell to the ground and was unresponsive. Medical personnel then arrived.

About 1220, 22 May 04, SA *7C1 661* interviewed of 1LT (DR.) *7C3-66-3* 391st MP BN Aid Station, BCCF, AGI, who stated he was called to Ganci #5 in reference to a detainee who had passed out and showed no signs of life. He said he arrived at 1040 and observed cardio pulmonary resuscitation (CPR) being performed on ALTIA. He found ALTIA showed no signs of life. He started an IV and instructed CPR to continue, as ALTIA was being transported to the hospital.

About 1000, 6 Jun 04, SA *7C-1 661* received the Preliminary Autopsy Report, #ME04-386, 1 Jun 04, which listed the cause of death as Atherosclerotic Cardiovascular Disease and the manner of death as Natural.

PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION REVEALED AT APPROXIMATELY 1030, 22 MAY 04, DETAINEE ALTIA COLLAPSED AFTER COMPLAINING OF CHEST PAIN TO HIS SON, *7c-3 bb-3*, NDRS *7c-4* AT 1040, 22 MAY 04, 1LT (DR.) *7c-3 bb-3*, 391ST MP BN AID STATION, BCCF, AGI, RESPONDED TO THE SCENE AND DETERMINED NO SIGNS OF LIFE WERE PRESENT.

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LIFE-SAVING MEASURES WERE INITIATED AS DETAINEE ALTIA WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE EMERGENCY ROOM.

ABOUT 1055, 22 MAY 04, DETAINEE ALTIA ARRIVED AT THE EMERGENCY ROOM AND WAS TREATED BY MAJ (DR) *TC 3 00-3* FORWARD SURGICAL TEAM (FST), BCCF, AGI. DR: *TC 3 00-3* DETERMINED SIGNS OF LIFE STILL DID NOT EXIST AND PRONOUNCED DETAINEE ALTIA DECEASED AT 1107, 22 MAY 04.

A VIEWING OF THE BODY BY USACIDC PERSONNEL REVEALED NO APPARENT SIGNS OF EXTRAORDINARY TRAUMA OR INJURY TO DETAINEE ALTIA.

AN AUTOPSY ON DETAINEE ALTIA IS PENDING.
